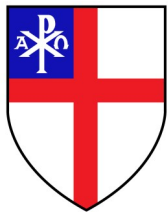

PRESIDING BISHOP'S EPISTLE

Praised be Jesus Christ!

After an unanticipatedly long delay due to the pleasantly intense activity in our Church, I am delighted to write you again in the second official Presiding Bishop's Epistle since last July. As you will see in the itinerary, the past ten months have been an extraordinarily busy and joyful time in our Church, as I have sought to travel the extent of the Eastern Diocese, to visit and support in person as many of you as possible, and to observe all the splendid goings-on in our Church family. To serve as your Presiding and Diocesan Bishop continues to be an indescribable blessing and inspiration. I thank God for all of you.

Please continue to pray for the healing, recovery, and good health of our beloved Bishop David Haines, as he convalesces following his cancer surgery. Please also remember Lucy and the family in your daily prayers.

Because there have been so many events and occasions as of late, this Epistle may read like a 'stream of consciousness!' Please bear with me.

One of the major developments in our Province over the past few months has been the remarkable opportunity to call Matthew (Stu) Stuart, a truly gifted and talented information technology professional, to serve full-time as our first APA Digital Media Director. Stu comes to us with many years of extensive experience in the computer field and has been diligently working since early March to assist us in the upgrading of our Provincial and Diocesan websites, in the creation of a new APA telephone application with instant news, information, and material available at one's fingertips, and the launching of new social media accounts on Facebook, YouTube, Twitter, Instagram, and Pinterest. Our Province received a tremendously gracious financial bequest on Christmas Eve which has made this new ministry possible. Moving our internet ministry to the next level of excellence has been and remains a top priority for our jurisdiction.

It would be a challenge to attempt to describe all the work and hours that must be invested in the creation of these new avenues of evangelistic outreach and Christian formation, and I am earnestly grateful for Stu's ministry, as I know you shall be as well. The newly upgraded APA and Diocesan websites will be unveiled before the Diocese of the Eastern United States Synod in September. A recording of the unveiling will be sent to our Diocese of the Central and Western States (DCWS) office for distribution among the DCWS. Our new website will feature podcasts, videos, my blog, user-friendly news and materials, and a full array of items by which to learn the Catholic Faith and to know more about our branch of Christ's Holy Church.

We have also asked Mary Willis Fife to spearhead a branding campaign to update and more historically to ground our symbols and shield. Our current APA shield was created in 1982, and, while it has been consistent with the other Continuing Church shields, and a strong and revered shield at that, we believe it was time to renew our look and to reflect forms and colours more in line with our Anglican origins. We also desire to fashion a version that is both fresh and current. Mary Willis, along with the input from Stu, a focus group of clergymen, Lisa, and myself, is fine-tuning the branding. The website and branding will be, God willing, presented at our DEUS Synod in September and shared with the DCWS simultaneously. Let us offer our profound thanks to Mary Willis for her creativity, research, imagination, and hard work, which have led to the creation of a new branding product that will withstand the test of time.

In the 21st century, nothing could be more important for bringing the Anglican Province of America into the reach of the world population and our local communities – our reinvigorated and expanded internet presence will be a major path, if not the key path, to making contact with the public at large. We wish to establish an updated internet ministry that will easily put at anyone's disposal all that is

needed to consider and embrace the fullness of the Christian Revelation as found in Catholic Anglicanism. Please pray for Stu in his work and ministry. We shall all be delighted with the advances we are about to behold online!

On 21st December, the Feast of Saint Thomas, I celebrated my 25th anniversary of Ordination to the Holy Priesthood at Saint Barnabas with a Solemn High Mass. Please know of my deepest appreciation for your prayers on that special occasion. Then, in a dramatic and heartbreaking turn, my loving, kind, and gracious father, a truly good and godly man, Robert Lee Jones, died after a brief hospitalization and hospice care on 2nd January 2022. He had suffered for a number of years from Alzheimer's disease and Parkinson's disease, but an inoperable intestinal blockage hastened his death at the age of 84. My family and I remain profoundly grateful for your love and prayers. Please continue to pray for my Dad's blessed repose and for the comfort and peace of my mother, Jo Ann.

In February, I led a retreat on the subject of spiritual warfare and the occult for the men of All Saints' Church, Charlottesville, Virginia, a retreat I repeated for the congregation of Saint James-on-the-Glebe Church, Gloucester, Virginia in May. The theme is a vital one for us in the spiritually vacuous culture in which we now live.

APA and Traditional Anglican Church

On 22nd May, Rogation Sunday, the Anglican Province of America and the Traditional Anglican Church (TAC) officially signed our agreement of full sacramental communion at Saint Barnabas Cathedral, the result of a meeting held with Archbishop Shane Janzen, Primate of the TAC, in Victoria, British Columbia, Canada in December. The full communion agreement has been approved by the House of Bishops of the APA and the College of Bishops of the TAC. The APA-TAC concordat restores full communion between our Churches and expands the full communion of the Continuing Church to an even greater extent worldwide, a breakthrough for the global Continuing Church movement. Present for the signing were Archbishop Janzen, Archbishop Brian Marsh (ACA), Archbishop Juan Garcia (ACA), and I. Our communion with the TAC creates a situation of 'mediate communion' wherein the APA is now in communion with the Anglican Catholic Church and the TAC. The only communion relationship which remains to be established for the closing of the circle is between the Anglican Catholic Church and the TAC. An ACC-TAC communion would be the final piece to be placed in this jigsaw puzzle – and then full communion would be restored, practically

speaking, for the entire Continuing Church worldwide. *Ut unum sint!*

APA Spring Retreat

It has been reported that our first-ever Spring Clergy Retreat held at the Ridgecrest Conference Centre in Black Mountain, North Carolina from 24th to 27th April was one of the most evenly-paced and enjoyable we have ever enjoyed together! Its goal was to provide formation for our clergy and ample time for camaraderie, fellowship, fun, and relaxation. I thank everyone who made the effort to join us. It was a privilege to spend some quality time with our clergy and to offer instruction on the theology and practice of the Missal in the Anglican Tradition. I welcome any additional feedback from attendees to make our next meeting even more fruitful. We shall certainly repeat the experience next year, perhaps at a beach setting.

Church Updates

Another exciting recent development, and a part of our Domestic Mission Team's plan, the first local mission effort in my administration, is our effort to bring a renewed focus on ministry to the mission of All Saints' Church, Palatka, Florida. Father Paul Beutell, with the support and encouragement of the Diocesan Standing Committee and our Domestic Missions Team, will assume his new ministry at All Saints' this summer. Father Paul will serve as Vicar and Father Frank Bartlett will continue to serve as assisting priest. Please pray for Father Paul and Cyndi, Father Frank and Geri, and their families, and for the people of All Saints', as this new project ensues.

It should be noted that two Churches have recently celebrated groundbreakings for new construction projects: Saint Matthias Church in Dothan, Alabama has launched its process for constructing a new building, its first ever building, and Saint Barnabas Cathedral, Atlanta (Dunwoody), Georgia, has broken ground for its new complex. The new Saint Barnabas addition and renovation should be completed by September. Lisa and Gary Ulrich relocated to the metropolitan Atlanta area in June, and very soon the new Diocesan and Provincial Office will be up and running at the Cathedral. Additionally, St. Patrick's Mission is making progress on the renovations of its new church building in Brevard, North Carolina.
